Mayor Botts gave us information about Banning's growth. There is a master plan for developing the airport and a 3 million square foot project north of I-10. A \$14 million police facility is under construction and the state has approved the building of a \$60 million court house here. In spite of budget challenges, the city is moving ahead with the downtown improvement project.

Mayor Fox was proud to report that Beaumont is highly ranked among well-run cities. Their budget is balanced and they have a high police to citizen ratio. The city council has five Republicans serving at this time. The city has a \$100 million capital improvements in the works.

By the time you receive this, the April 1 meeting of Southern Division will have taken place. I'm proud to tell you that our club was represented by 10 of our officers/members. The keynote speaker was Assemblyman Chuck DeVore (Orange County) who has announced his candidacy for the U.S. Senate seat held by Barbara Boxer. 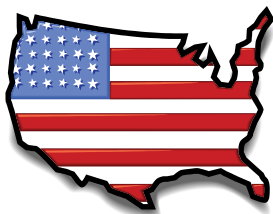

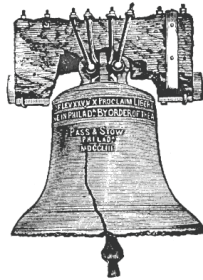
not warming, and the evidence is mounting that "climate change" is a natural occurrence and that man has nothing to do with it.

AIG FIASCO

After a nearly 150 billion dollar bailout, AIG handed over 165 million in bonus pay to their top executives invoking the wrath of pretty much every single man, woman and child in America. Democrats and Republicans were equally outraged; there were protests outside the executives' homes, and even death threats against them and their families. Congress immediately began yelling, screaming and hollering, yodeling, and warning to the idea of a mass AIG seppuku, which finally resulted in the passage of a House bill that lops off 90% of the executives' bonus pay, the legality of which is still in question. How about some government bodily protection after, uh, all that great government financial protection?

POPULARITY DROPPING? FOR THE PREZ

Obama's popularity has plummeted for the first time since he became our Dear Leader, according to a poll released last week by the Pew Research Center for People and the Press. In February, Pew had Obama at a 64% approval rating, but last month he dropped 5 points to 59%. As for the "hate factor", only 17% of Ameri-

NETWORKING FOR SUCCESS

The goal of networking is to bring together people who are your potential members and supporters.

- Be a good listener. Engage people in conversation.
- Do more listening than talking, “connect” with the people who will make a difference in your life and in your RWF club.
- Practice networking in a systematic and organized manner to achieve your RWF goals.
- Make a written commitment to yourself to block out time on your calendar for networking.
- Maintain notes on who provided information such as ideas, critiques and referrals for future reference. This information may prove to be valuable later.
- Be diverse in your networking contacts – you never know who can connect you to a world of people that otherwise you may not meet.
- Reconnect with members from the past – call those who haven't renewed or those who suddenly aren't attending meetings.

Recognize that there are three different kinds of people when networking: those you wait and watch for things to happen; those who make things happen; those who wonder what happened.

You become the catalyst, the spark that makes things happen.

- Point out how membership and participation will make their life better. The message that you deliver is the benefit and value to the wavering member or potential member, to the support person or advisor. Be positive when someone inquires about the Republican Women clubs. Provide information on accomplishments, keep it simple so that it will be repeated to others, let people know that they can help in many ways – there is a place for them.

Meet and acquire advice from leaders of other volunteer and service organizations as you create your own web of contacts.

Becoming a master networker is a journey, which you fine tune to perfection over time.



Assemblyman Paul Cook Introduces AB562 to Reform Health Insurance Pricing –

Assembly Bill 562 will promote transparency of rising health care premiums by giving employers greater access to information about costs for their health plans. The bill would protect individual employees' privacy rights, while requiring insurance companies to disclose true plan costs to employers. The legislation applies pressure to health carriers to disclose claim loss experience. This experience is used by health insurers to price employer group plan costs, but is not shared with the employer who is paying the premiums. AB562 legislation encourages (and to a large extent enables) employer groups and their brokers to more effectively “shop around”. Virtually any time markets experience more price competition, average prices decline and consumer welfare increases.
