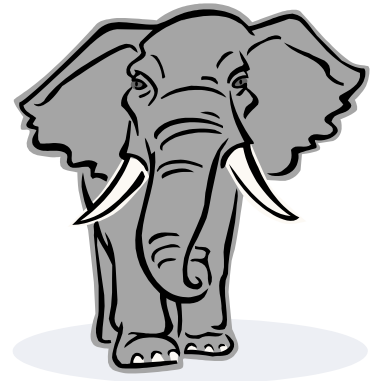

UNDERSTANDING SHARIA LAW or HOW TO ENSLAVE YOURSELF OPPOSITION RESEARCH/NATIONAL ISSUES —————SHEILA BRYAN

Perhaps some women have not yet looked into the enslavement of Muslim women in countries that follow Sharia Law according to the Koran. Jim Horn and Robert Spencer have spoken to many Republican Women Clubs, and described their experiences in these countries that live under Sharia, but there are still those who wonder how this ancient set of standards will affect liberated women in our own country.

Did anyone expect to see the word “Dhimmitude” in the Obamacare bill? No wonder Nancy Pelosi said you have to pass the bill to see what’s in it! It is on page 107 in the bill. It establishes Sharia Muslim law in the United States. Muslims are exempted from the government mandate to purchase insurance and from the penalty tax for being uninsured. Islam considers insurance to be “gambling” and is banned. Louis Farrakhan will have no penalty and will have 100% of his health needs paid for by the government insurance. All Christians and Jews will have crippling IRS liens placed against all of our assets and will face jail or a penalty tax if we refuse to buy insurance under Obama Care.



Dhimmitude is the Muslim system of controlling non-Muslim populations conquered through jihad (war). Jihad is a demand for total submission and if non-Muslims (Kafir) do not willingly submit then force may be used. The dhimmi must submit in a formal way to political Islam. Dhimmi’s are any who do not follow the Koran, Muhammad and Allah, as a devout Muslim.

Sharia Law demands that our institutions submit to Islam. Our schools must submit to how they teach about Islam. Our media must present Islam in a good light. Every facet of our civilization must submit eventually. Women under Sharia Law are considered inferior to the male and beatings are allowed to enforce the rule of the male. There is no penalty for killing an adulteress, even though it does not accord honor killing a legal status. The man rules the woman to this day in Muslim ruled countries. We have seen in

the news, women being stoned while buried to their necks.

Islam is not just a religion. It is a complete civilization with a political system, religion and a legal code – the Sharia. Sharia claims political supremacy over the Constitution. Even though Sharia violates every principle of our Constitution, it is being implemented today, because Americans are unaware about Sharia or its meaning. Western civilization cannot survive under Sharia law.

The ACLU fights to protect the use of foreign law – including Muslim Sharia law - in America’s courtrooms. They file lawsuits to tear down Ten Commandments displays in courthouses and Christmas trees and Manger scenes in the public square. They are responsible for prayer being banned in our schools. Updates and Deadlines

There is one week left of regular session for the legislature, so there is a flurry of floor action and bills passed and sent to the Governor. Two bills that the CFRW opposed have passed out of the legislature and are on their way to Governor Brown. Both AB 131 (Cedillo, D-45) and AB 499 (Atkins, D-76) passed and the Governor has 30 days to act on the legislation. AB 131 is the second of two bills that make up the California Dream Act. If signed by the Governor, AB 131 would allow illegal residents to apply for public funding for higher education. We can barely afford to provide higher education benefits for legal students, yet Democrats believe we should give ILLEGAL students the opportunity for public funding or grants. The other bill, AB 499, allows minors 12 years and older to be treated for sexually transmitted diseases without parental consent. The Democrats priorities are completely backwards. Both bills have been analyzed in previous Capitol Updates.

Let the Governor know that you disapprove of these bills. Tell the Governor to **VETO** AB 131 and AB 499.
